Selection Posts/Ladakh/2022 (Higher Secondary (10+2) Level posts) – Declaration of Result of Computer Based Examination thereby shortlisting candidates for next stage of scrutiny

Staff Selection Commission conducted Computer Based Examination for **Higher Secondary (10+2)** Level posts under Selection Posts/Ladakh/2022 Examination from 01-08-2022 to 05-08-2022 at various centers all over the country.

2. Marks scored by the candidates have been normalized as per provisions mentioned under Para 14.3 of the Notice of the examination. Such normalized marks have been used for fixing cut-off marks to qualify candidates for the next stage of Scrutiny.

3. Representations received from candidates regarding tentative Answer Keys were carefully examined and answer keys were suitably modified wherever required and finalized thereafter. The final answer keys have been used for evaluation of performance of candidates in the Examination.

4. As per Para 18.7 of the Notice of the Examination, candidates scoring minimum marks in the computer based examination, as given below, have been considered eligible for shortlisting to the next stage of Scrutiny:

(i) UR	:	35% (i.e. 70 marks)
(ii) EWS	:	30% (i.e. 60 marks)
(iii) All other reserved categories	:	25% (i.e. 50 marks)

5. As per recruitment procedure mentioned at Para-18.8 of the Notice of the above mentioned Examination, 865 candidates have been shortlisted for the next stage of scrutiny based on the normalized score and merit of candidates in the Computer Based Examination, in the following ratio:

- (a) 1:20 for vacancies up to 5 (subject to the availability of suitable candidates).
- (b) 1:10 subject to minimum 100 for vacancies more than 5 (subject to the availability of suitable candidates).

6. Category-wise break-up of the candidates shortlisted in the Computer Based Examination for the next stage of Scrutiny are as follows:

7. Post-Category wise cut-off details of candidates qualified against vacancies for **Higher Secondary (10+2)** level posts and number of candidates shortlisted, are given in **Annexure-I**.

8. The candidates **who are shortlisted for next stage of scrutiny as per Annexure-I are required to submit a copy of all the supporting Documents** (Self Attested) in respect of Educational Qualification (EQ), Experience, Category, Age, Age-relaxation, etc. (as applicable) **in hard copy along with the print out of their online application form** to the Staff Selection Commission Northern Western Region, by **16th January, 2023 by SPEED POST ONLY**. The candidates should clearly mention the **"Higher Secondary (10+2) level"** and **"Post-Category No....."** on the **TOP of the Envelope** while sending the documents to the SSC(NWR) by Speed Post.

9. It may be noted that if a candidate has applied for 3 (three) categories of posts, for example, NW22622, NW22422 and NW22122, then he/ she has to submit his/ her requisite documents in hard copy, to SSC(NWR) for each category of Post i.e. for Post-Category No. NW22622, for Post-Category No. NW22422 and for Post-Category No. NW22122 separately.

NOTE:- IF PRINTOUT OF THE ONLINE APPLICATION FORM ALONGWITH THE REQUISITE DOCUMENTS IN HARD COPY IS NOT RECEIVED IN THE RESPECTIVE REGIONAL OFFICE BY 16th January, 2023, CANDIDATURE OF SUCH CANDIDATES WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR THE SCRUTINY AND FURTHER STAGES OF THE EXAMINATION. THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY POSTAL DELAYS.

12. Resolution of tie cases - In the event of tie in scores of candidates in the Computer Based Examination, such cases have been resolved by applying following criteria, one after another, till the tie is resolved:

- i. Total marks in Computer Based Examination.
- ii. Marks in Part-A of Computer Based Examination.
- iii. Marks in Part-B of Computer Based Examination.
- iv. Date of Birth, with older candidates placed higher.
- v. Alphabetical order of names (starting with first name)

13. Skill Test, wherever prescribed for any category of post(s) will be conducted from amongst the shortlisted candidates whose hard copies of documents are received and found in order at Scrutiny stage, by the concerned Regional Office of the Commission. Due intimation in advance will be given by the concerned Regional Office i.e. SSC(NWR) to the candidates through their website.

14. In case, during the stage of Scrutiny of documents/DV, the Commission observes that the vacancy(ies) for a particular category of Post(s) is/are not getting filled up completely, an additional number of candidates who have qualified in the Computer Based Examination, in the order of merit, shall be called ONLY FOR ONE MORE TIME, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMISSION for filling up the number of vacancies not getting filled up, in the ratio of 1:20 for vacancies upto 5 (subject to the availability of suitable candidates) and 1:10 for vacancies more than 5 subject to minimum 100 candidates.

15. All qualified candidates found clear at the Scrutiny Stage for a particular category of post, will be called for Document Verification (DV) by the concerned Regional Office i.e. SSC(NWR). Accordingly, Admission Certificate for Document Verification will be issued by SSC(NWR).

16. Marks of the candidates will not be disclosed at this stage. The candidature of the shortlisted candidates is provisional.

17. For further stages of recruitment, candidates may visit the websites of the concerned Regional Office i.e. SSC(NWR) regularly.
