Notification for the Engagement of Apprentices under the Apprentices Act, 1961 for F.Y. 2026-27

Central Bank of India, a leading Public Sector Bank, with Pan India Branch Network of more than 4,500 plus branches, with total business of more than Rs. 812000 crores, driven by talented work force of more than 34,000 plus employees invites applications **for the Engagement of Apprentices**, under the Apprentices Act, 1961 and as per Apprenticeship policy of the Bank. Central Bank of India, established in 1911 is the first Indian Commercial bank which was wholly owned and managed by Indians. Selected candidates will be engaged in branches/offices in the respective regions at the discretion of the Bank.

NOTE:

The detail of the state-wise vacancies is attached as Annexure I. Further, kindly note as under:

- The number of vacancies/reserved vacancies is tentative and may vary according to the actual requirement of the Bank during the engagement process. Such modifications/change, if any in the number of vacancies shall be notified on Bank's website.
- Candidates belonging to reserved categories are free to apply against vacancies announced for the Unreserved/General category, provided they meet the eligibility criteria laid down for General Category candidates.
- Reservation guidelines as laid down by the Government of India from time to time for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWBD etc. shall be followed.

Medical Fitness, Verification of Documents, Character and caste certificate (wherever applicable) verification of selected candidates:

The engagement of selected candidates will be subject to their being declared medically fit by a duly qualified medical practitioner or subject to production of medical certification from MBBS Doctors or both, as per the discretion of the Bank. Further, engagement will be subject to document verification conducted by the Bank officials and upon satisfactory verification of candidates' character, antecedents and caste validity certificates (wherever applicable). Till such time, their engagement will be provisional. It is to be noted that:

- a) The reservation for Physically Challenged persons is on a horizontal basis and the selected candidates will be placed in the appropriate category (viz. SC/ST/OBC/EWS/UR-GEN) to which they belong.
- b) The number of seats for apprentices and the number of reserved seats is provisional and may vary according to the actual requirements of the bank.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: -

The cut-off date for the Eligibility Criteria is 31.05.2026. Before applying, candidates are requested to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria for the post as on the cut-off date of eligibility.

The Eligibility Criteria and other details for the Engagement of Apprentices shall be as under: -

Nationality/Citizenship

A candidate must be either

- i.a Citizen of India or
- ii.a subject of Nepal or
- iii.a subject of Bhutan or
- iv.a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India or
- v.a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India

Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (ii), (iii), (iv) & (v) above shall be a person in whose favor a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India.

* Candidates must have been born not earlier than 31.05.1998 and not later than 31.05.2006 (both days inclusive) Maximum age indicated is for unreserved and EWS candidates. Relaxation in upper age limit is applicable as per Government of India guidelines for SC/ST/OBC/PwBD.

Candidates must have completed Graduation on or after 01.01.2022 onwards. Candidates must produce marksheets and Provisional/Degree certificate issued from the University/College as and when require by the Bank.

Relaxation in Upper Age Limit:

The relaxation of Upper Age limit is applicable as per the Reservation table available for different states as mentioned above.

Note: -

1. Please note that change of category submitted by the applicant will not be permitted at any stage after registration of online application.
2. Candidates belonging to OBC category but coming in the 'creamy layer' and/or if their caste does not find place in the Central List are not entitled to OBC reservation and age relaxation will not be applicable to such candidate. They should indicate their category as "GENERAL" or GENERAL (OC/HI/VI/ID) as applicable.
3. Benefit of reservation under EWS category is permissible only upon production of an 'Income and Asset Certificate' issued by a Competent Authority in the format prescribed.
4. Caste/EWS/PwBD certificate issued by Competent Authority on format prescribed by the Government of India will have to be submitted by the candidates applying under SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD category, while submitting their application(s).
5. The number of training vacancies including reserved vacancies mentioned above are provisional and may vary according to the actual requirement of the bank during the engagement process.
6. Reservation for PwBD is horizontal and within the overall training vacancies for the State.
7. Candidates seeking age relaxation will be required to submit copies of necessary certificate(s) at the time of selection process and at any subsequent stage of the selection process as required by the Bank.
8. Maximum age indicated is for General Category candidates as on 31.05.2026. Relaxation in upper age limit will be available as detailed above.
9. Engagement of Apprentices will be subject to his/her being declared medically fit as per the requirement of the Bank.

Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities:

Under section 34 of "The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016", persons with benchmark disabilities are eligible for Reservation. The reserved categories of disabilities mentioned under this Act are namely:

- a) Visually Impairment (VI) - Blindness and Low Vision.
- b) Hearing Impaired (HI) - Deaf and Hard of Hearing.
- c) Orthopedically Challenged (OC) - Locomotor Disability (One Arm - OA, One Leg -OL, Both Legs -BL, One Arm & One Leg -OAL),
- d) Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, Dwarfism, Acid Attack Victims, and Muscular Dystrophy.
- e) Intellectual Disability (ID) - Intellectual Disability (Autism Spectrum Disorder, Specific Learning Disability and Mental Illness) & Multiple Disability.
- f) Multiple Disabilities means disability amongst clauses (a) to (d), including deaf blindness in the posts identified for each disability.

The definition of the above-specified disabilities & allocation of reserved vacancies for persons with benchmark disabilities will be as prescribed in "The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016" and as per the training vacancies advertised.

A person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation will have to submit a latest Disability Certificate, on prescribed format, issued by Medical Authority or any other notified Competent Authority (Certifying Authority) in the district of the applicant's residence as mentioned in the proof of residence in the application. The certificate should be dated on or before last date of registration of application. Such certificate shall be subject to verification/re-verification as may be decided by the Board /Competent Authority.

Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs):

Persons who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations to the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes and the Other Backward Classes (Central List) and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 08 lakhs (Rupees Eight Lakhs only) are to be identified as EWS for the benefit of reservation.

The income shall include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. and it will be income for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also, persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:

- a. 05 acres of agricultural land and above;
- b. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- c. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- d. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places /cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine the EWS status.

The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of Income and Asset Certificate issued by any one of the authorities as notified by Government of India in the prescribed format.

Selection Process:

Selection for engagement of candidates who apply for apprenticeship in the Bank after paying requisite online fee shall have to undergo the selection process based on Online Test to be conducted by BFSI SSC and Test of Local Language of the State.

Online Examination:

The tentative structure of the Online examination (Objective type) would be as follows: -

** Bank reserves the right to modify the structure of the examination.

There will be no negative marks for wrong answers in the Objective tests.

- Selection will be based on merit as per vacancies.
- Merit List is to be drawn depending upon the vacancy.
- In case more than one candidate scores same marks in the Merit List, such candidate will be ranked in the merit list according to their age in descending order.
- The details regarding Central Bank of India Products & Services will be shared in due course of time on website <https://centralbank.bank.in/en/recruitments>

After the online examination, the result of the candidates who have provisionally qualified for selection will be made available on the Bank's and BFSI SSC's website.

Test of Local Language:

- The candidates applying for training seats of a particular state, should be proficient (reading, writing, speaking, and understanding) in any one of the specified local/official languages of that State, as mentioned in the Annexure-II.
- The test for knowledge of specified opted local language will be conducted as a part of selection process. It will be conducted after qualifying the online examination. Candidates who fail to qualify this test may not be engaged for apprentice. However, candidates who produce 10th or 12th standard mark sheet having studied the specified opted local language of the State will not be required to undergo the language test.
- Candidates will have to appear for the test of the specified opted local language at a centre (to be decided by the Bank) of the State applied for, at his/her own expenses. The Bank will not reimburse or bear any travelling expenses that may be incurred by the candidates for attending the said test.

Note: - Other detailed information regarding the examination process will be given in the "Information Handout", and the same will be made available to all eligible candidates by BFSI SSC.

Final Selection:

The final selection of the apprentices will be subject to

- Meeting the cut-off marks in the online examination to be decided by the Bank.
- Satisfactory verification of the documents related to Date of Birth/Category/Educational Qualification and other information furnished in the online application.
- Qualifying the test of the specified local language of the State
- Being found Medically Fit as per the requirement of the Bank.

Contract of Apprenticeship:

Candidates found suitable for engagement based on the merit list after successful document verification shall be issued digital apprenticeship contracts through the government apprenticeship portals, i.e. <https://nats.education.gov.in>

Candidates shall receive the link for the digital apprenticeship contract from the BFSI SSC and need to accept it on the respective portal(s) within a stipulated time/date as mentioned therein. No candidate shall be engaged as an Apprentice or undergo apprenticeship training in any designated trade/optional trade unless and until he/she enters Contract of Apprenticeship with the Bank and the same is approved by the Authorities of the respective Portals.

Duration of training:

The duration of training is twelve months. The apprentices shall be imparted training on different aspects of banking practices, products and processes.

Stipend/Benefits:

The apprentices are eligible for a stipend of Rs 15,000/- per month for the engagement period of one year. The apprentices are not eligible for any other allowances/benefits.

Training Condition/Overtime/Leave/Holidays:

- Apprentice shall be entitled to such holidays as are observed in the Bank.
- Apprentice shall be entitled to one casual leave every month during the period of Apprenticeship.
- No other type of leave is applicable for the Apprentices.
- The daily hours of work will be as applicable to the clerical staff of the Bank.
- No apprentice shall be required or allowed to work overtime.

Assessment and Certification:

After the completion of apprenticeship training, apprentices may need to go through an assessment test. The certificate will be awarded as per prevailing guidelines.

Termination of Apprenticeship Contract:

- The Contract of Apprenticeship shall be terminated if the apprentice does not report at the Bank's Training venue / Bank Branch on the date of commencement of On-Job-Training.
- The Contract of Apprenticeship shall automatically terminate on expiry of the period of Apprenticeship Training.
- The Bank or the Apprentice can make an application to the Apprenticeship Advisor for the termination of the contract before the completion of the apprenticeship period, stating clearly the reason for termination. When such an application is made, a copy of the same shall be sent by post to the other party.
- Apprenticeship Advisor (BFSI SSC) may, by order in writing, terminate the contract if he is satisfied that the apprentice or the Bank has failed to carry out the terms and conditions of the contract.
- Provided that where a contract is terminated-
 - For failure on the part of Bank to carry out the terms and conditions of the contract, the Bank shall pay to the apprentice such compensation as determined by the Apprenticeship Advisor; For such failure on the part of apprentice, the apprentice shall refund the Bank as cost of training such amount as may be determined by the Apprenticeship Advisor.

The bank can terminate the contract of an apprentice due to misconduct by the apprentice, with a notice mentioning the reason.

Conduct and Discipline:

As per Section 17 of the Apprentices Act, 1961, amended from time to time, in all matters of Conduct and Discipline, the apprentice shall be governed by the 'Rules and procedure for disciplinary action against Workmen' of the Central Bank of India.

Application Fees/Intimation Charges (Non-Refundable):

Application/Examination/Intimation fee to be remitted by all eligible applicants to the scrutinizing/examining body deputed by the Bank is as under (**GST @ 18% extra will be charged on application fee**):

Candidates can make the payment of requisite fees/intimation charges through the ONLINE mode only and no other mode of payment is acceptable:

Fee/ Intimation charges once paid will NOT be refunded on any account nor can it be held in reserve for any other exam or selection.

Other Terms and Conditions:

- The Candidate should NOT have undergone Apprenticeship either in Central Bank of India or in any other organization/establishment earlier or be pursuing Apprenticeship Training as per the Apprentices Act 1961 as amended from time to time.
- The training duration/apprenticeship or engagement period shall be 12 months, and Govt of India Guidelines will be followed for leave, working conditions, and holidays.
- Candidates who had training or job experience for one year or more after the attainment of the educational qualifications, shall NOT be eligible for being engaged as Apprentices.
- No Ex-servicemen / Disabled Ex-Servicemen shall be engaged as an apprentice, and there is no reservation for ex-servicemen/ Disabled ex-servicemen in the apprentice engagement.
- The apprentice shall have no right to claim employment in the Bank after completion of training.
- The Bank shall have no obligation to offer regular employment to Apprentices during and/or after the completion of the apprenticeship period. After completion of the apprenticeship period, candidates will be relieved from the respective work area. The Apprentices engaged by the Bank will not be provided with any Transport / Hostel facility or any other form of residential accommodation during Apprentice training
- Every apprentice undergoing apprenticeship training in the Bank shall be a TRAINEE for all purposes and not considered as a WORKER or EMPLOYEE of the Bank; as such, the provisions of any law concerning labour shall not apply to or about such apprentice.

- He/She will not be entitled to receive any benefits that are available for the employees of the Bank.
- The bank has the right to cancel the engagement of the apprentices engaged at any point in time without prior notice, in case of any misconduct by the apprentice during the engagement period.
- The Apprentices are prohibited from joining/forming any Union Body.
- Any dispute arising out of this advertisement for the engagement of apprentices will be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts in Mumbai.
- The process of application is complete only when the fee is deposited, through online mode, on or before the last date of payment of the fee. Candidates are advised to check the Bank's website regularly for details and updates. No separate intimation/advertisement, etc. will be issued in case of any change/update.
- The Bank decision will be final and binding on all candidates on all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of applications, mode of selection, and cancellation of the selection process either in part or in full, etc.
- No correspondence will be entertained in this regard. Filling up of the seats is solely at the discretion of the Bank based on the suitability of candidates, and no claim can be made for engagement if some of these seats are not filled due to unsuitability / insufficient number of candidates.
- The incomplete Online applications shall not be considered as "Eligible" and treated as "Rejected". No communication will be entertained in this regard.
- Candidates should satisfy themselves about their eligibility before applying for engagement as apprentice in the Bank.
- Not more than one application should be submitted by a candidate. In case of multiple applications, only the last valid (completed) application will be retained, and the application fee/ intimation charge paid for other registration will stand forfeited. Multiple attendance/appearance by a candidate in the examination will be summarily rejected/candidature will be cancelled.
- The possibility for occurrence of some problems in the administration of the examination cannot be ruled out completely, which may impact test delivery and/or result from being generated. In that event, every effort will be made to rectify such a problem, which may include the conduct of another examination if considered necessary.
- Candidates are advised to take a printout of their system-generated online application form after applying.
- Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority, strictly in the prescribed format as stipulated by the Government of India, in case of SC/ ST/OBC/EWS category candidates. (as enclosed in the Annexure) will have to be submitted by the candidate at the time of document verification or as and when called by the Bank.
- The benefit of reservation under the EWS category can be availed upon production of an 'Income and Asset Certificate' issued by the Competent Authority on the format prescribed by the Government of India for the relevant financial year.

- PwBD candidates should produce disability certificate, on the prescribed format, issued by a competent authority as per the Government of India Guidelines.
- Candidates are advised to keep their registered e-mail ID/mobile active for receiving advice, and instructions.
- Engagement of selected candidates is subject to his/her being declared medically fit as per the requirement of the Bank and such engagement will also be subject to all relevant rules/policies/guidelines of the Bank.
- Any legal proceedings in respect of any matter of claim or dispute arising out of this advertisement and/or an application in response thereto can be instituted only in Mumbai, and Courts/Tribunals/Forums at Mumbai only shall have sole and exclusive jurisdiction to try any cause/dispute.
- The candidates will have to appear for the selection process at their own cost. Central Bank of India will not pay or reimburse any such expenses.

GUIDELINES FOR FILLING ONLINE APPLICATION:

- Candidates can apply online, and no other mode of application will be accepted.
- Candidates should mandatorily first register themselves, if eligible, in the apprenticeship portals of Government of India viz NATS portal <https://nats.education.gov.in> (Navigate to the “Student Register/Login” section)
- In case the candidates are facing issues in getting themselves registered they are advised to go through the help manual available on the respective apprenticeship portals. For NATS portal refer to “Candidate User Manual” on https://nats.education.gov.in/assets/manual/student_manual.pdf
- All candidates are supposed to remember their respective login id and passwords of the apprenticeship portals as applicable to them, as they will be repetitively visiting the apprenticeship portals for various activities till their completion of the apprenticeship program
- For NATS portal, candidates can view the Apprenticeship Advertisement of “Central Bank of India” after login into the portal by visiting https://nats.education.gov.in/student_type.php.
- It is very IMPORTANT for all candidates who have applied to MAKE NOTE of their Enrolment Id (issued by NATS portal) for all the future correspondence.
- All Candidates who have applied successfully for the Apprenticeship Opportunity/Advertisement on NATS will receive an email reminder from BFSI SSC (info@bfsissc.com) inviting them to register themselves on <https://beep.bfsissc.com> to complete their final application process for the Apprenticeship Program of Central Bank of India by providing the required details about the caste category, choice of districts for their apprenticeship training, etc. and making the payment of the applicable application cum examination cum intimation fees.
- Candidates should scan their photograph, signature & documents as detailed under guidelines for respective apprenticeship portals.
- Candidates are advised to carefully fill in the online application themselves as no change in any of the data filled in the online application will be possible/ entertained at a later stage. Prior to submission of

the online application, candidates are advised to verify the details in the online application form and modify the same if required.

- No change is permitted after clicking on SUBMIT button. Visually Impaired candidates will be responsible for getting the details filled in/carefully verifying, in the online application and ensuring that the same are correct prior to submission as no change is possible after submission. ix.
- The name of the candidate should be spelt correctly in the application as it appears in the certificates/mark sheets. Any change/ alteration found may disqualify the candidature.

ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:

- 1.1 Candidates are advised in their own interest that they should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered, fabricated or should not suppress any material information while filling up the application form.
- 1.2 At the time of Examination, if a candidate is/has been found guilty of:
 - using unfair means during the examination or
 - impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or
 - misbehaving during the examination or disclosing, publishing, reproducing, transmitting, storing or facilitating transmission and storage of contents of the test(s) or any information therein in whole or part thereof in any form or by any means, verbal or written, electronically or mechanically for any purpose

- resorting to any irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for selection or obtaining support for his/her candidature by any means, such a candidate may in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable:
 - (a) to be **disqualified** from the examination for which he/she is a candidate
 - (b) To be **debarred**, either permanently or for a specified period, from any examination or recruitment conducted by the Bank
 - (c) For **termination** from the apprenticeship training, if he/she has already joined the apprenticeship training of the Bank.

Important: The test conducting agency, would be analysing the responses (answers) of individual candidates with other candidates to detect patterns of similarity of right and wrong answers. If in the analytical procedure adopted by test conducting agency in this regard, it is inferred/ concluded that the responses have been shared and scores obtained are not genuine/ valid, in such cases Bank reserves the right to cancel the candidature of the concerned candidates and the result of such candidates (disqualified) will be withheld.

INTIMATION FOR ONLINE TEST/ DOCUMENT VERIFICATION:

- Candidates who register and apply successfully on <https://beep.bfsissc.com> would get all updates in the “**My Applied Opportunities**” section regarding online examination date & time and the process to be followed. **Since the Online examination has to be given from candidate’s own residence and own device, no admit card is required.
